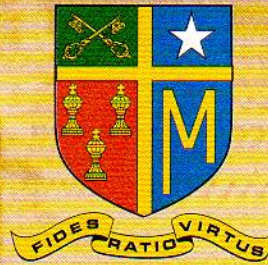

2010-2011 Admissions Packet Checklist

Thank you for your interest in attending John Paul II High School for the 2010-2011 school year. Attached you will find our admission packet which must be completed by May 1, 2010. The completed packet may be mailed to the address listed above, or dropped off at the front office.

Admission to John Paul II High School is based on the following:

Step 1: Student Application and Registration Fee

a) Families interested in pursuing enrollment must complete the Application for Admission Form and submit the \$115 registration fee* by *May 1, 2010*.

* The registration fee will be refunded in the event that your child is denied admission to John Paul II High School.

b) The following items need to be submitted as a completed packet.

- Copies of the following documents **MUST** be included: If Applicable:

c) Request for financial aid (Smart Tuition) if needed. Application form is enclosed.

- Parents interested in requesting tuition assistance must complete the enclosed Tuition Analysis Request Form and mail the form to Smart Tuition, our tuition management company, with the required information by, May 1, 2010.
- Please note that Smart Tuition will provide a financial needs analysis which will be used to determine tuition assistance grants. The company cannot accurately determine financial need if the applicant fails to either provide the required documentation or fails to mail the form in a timely manner.
- There will be a \$48 application fee. This fee will be credited back to the applicant on their first Smart invoice.



Step 2: Parent/Student Interviews

- John Paul II High School staff will call to set up an appointment for a 10-15 minute interview once Smart Tuition has returned the financial needs analysis.
- Parents who are not requesting tuition assistance will be contacted as soon as the admission packet is complete.
- Acceptance or regret letters will be given at the end of the interview.

Step 3: Sign Contract

- Fill out and sign the appropriate forms before leaving.

➤ Admission Policies:

Admission to John Paul II High School is based on academic performance, attendance and discipline records, a desire to participate in the values and mission promoted by John Paul II High School, and support from both parents and students of the school's policies.

Please note that the data collected from the transcript and submitted test scores will be used to place accepted students in classes that will support their academic goals.

➤ Transfer Procedures:

Transfer applicants applying for entry as sophomores, juniors, or seniors, are admitted according to the above admission policies and availability. Transfer applicants must follow the same procedures as incoming freshman applicants.
