

Dress Code Clarifications

Please take note of a few necessary changes that were essential to the dress code for the 2009-2010 school year.

1. The gold polo shirt for the boys and girls will no longer be an option for regular class days. It may however, be worn on spirit days, field trips, or other events approved by the administration.
2. Shorts will no longer be an option for boys or girls on regular class days.
3. Tennis shoes will no longer be an option on regular class days.

The current dress code will be as follows:

All clothing must be from Parker's, Myra's, or of the same brand and type.

Regular School Days:

Boys: Long khaki pants

White or black polo shirts

Black or brown leather dress shoes

Black or brown ankle socks

White or black undershirt with black polo shirt*

White only undershirt with white polo shirt*

Belts must be black or brown with a simple belt buckle

Please note that boys hair will not be able to touch the collar in the back, will not reach the eyebrows in the front, and cannot be longer than two inches off the scalp.

Girls: Long khaki pants, plaid skirts or plaid skorts

(length of skirt must be to the center of the knee when standing)

White or black polo shirts

Black or brown leather dress shoes (1 inch heel or less)

Black or brown ankle socks with the khaki pants

White socks (ankle length or longer) with the skirt or skort

White or black undershirt with black polo shirt*

White undershirt with white polo shirt*

Mass Days

Dress code for mass days is the same as last year for boys and girls. **A more detailed explanation of the dress code will appear in the student handbook**

*Undershirts are not required; however, if students choose to wear them under their uniform shirts, they must follow guidelines stated above.
